WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12: 6:00 p.m.: Senior Banquet will be held at the Top of the Tower, Holiday Inn Downtown, 1050 Sixth Avenue in Des Moines. **Tickets and payment must be made by Monday March 20 through Friday, April 7, at 3:00 p.m. in the Bookkeepers office.** January graduates may see (or call) Ms. Davis in the school V.P. office for tickets and payment. This event is for seniors only. The cost is \$20.00 for the Senior Banquet. **You will need your Roosevelt Student I.D. to purchase your ticket AND to enter the banquet.**

WEDNESDAY, MAY 10: 7:30 a.m.: Seniors need to stop in the V.P. office and pick up their senior checkout cards. All forms must be taken around to teachers for the teacher to sign off. Students must get signatures of Roosevelt and Central Campus staff in order to graduate. Students should not interrupt a teacher during instruction time. The form is returned for the final signature to the Senior Vice Principal. January Grads, pick up the week of January 9, 2017.

SATURDAY, MAY 6: 8:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m.: Senior Prom will be held at the SCOTTISH RITE 519 PARK STREET Des Moines, IA. Tickets for Prom will be sold in the Bookkeepers office before school, at lunch, and after school from April 24 through the final day Wednesday, May 3 at 3:00 pm. Guest forms will be available in the V.P. office beginning on April 10th and will need to be filled out and returned when student purchases their ticket to the V.P. office. Cost is \$30.00 per ticket. Guest tickets that are not Roosevelt Seniors will be \$30.00. Roosevelt underclass may be asked as guests. **You will need your Roosevelt Student I.D. to purchase your ticket AND to enter the dance. All school Fines and Fees MUST be paid before a prom ticket is purchased!**

WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, FRIDAY, MONDAY MAY 17, 18, 19, AND 22: Senior final exams are given during the regular class period schedule with Blocks 7 and 8 Wednesday; Blocks 3 and 4 Thursday; Blocks 5 and 6 Friday and Blocks 1 and 2 Monday. **Seniors will have until Thursday May 25th at 3:00pm to completed all class assignments and projects per the Senior Contract. All Names for the Graduation Program will go to the printer on May 23 at 12:00pm!**

TUESDAY, May 16: Seniors request their final transcripts (8 semesters) sent to colleges. A final eight-semester transcript is required for any senior who plans to attend college in the fall. Complete all specifics on the form from the Registrar's Office and turn it in at the table in front of the cap and gown check-out window along with a stamped, addressed, business-size envelope.

FRIDAY, MAY 26: 8:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.: Graduation Practice, Rehearsal for Commencement (Mandatory for all Seniors) in the Roosevelt Auditorium. Students should arrive at 8:15am to find their seat and receive their information packet. Attendance at rehearsal is required of all seniors (January graduates included) who are participating in the Commencement exercise. Caps, gowns, tassels and honor cords will be issued immediately following rehearsal. All class work and delinquencies and money owed to the school must be taken care of before your cap and gown will be issued to you unless extenuating circumstances and has been discussed with the Roosevelt Administration. Students owing money, books, equipment (or other delinquencies) on graduation day will be permitted to participate in the ceremony, but will not be issued their diplomas until all indebtedness is cleared. **All names for the Graduation Program will go to the printer on May 23 at 12:00pm!**

SATURDAY, MAY 27: 7:30 p.m.: Commencement Exercises will be held at Knapp Center at Drake. Knapp Center is located at 2525 Forest Ave. Des Moines IA 50311. Seniors are to report (by 6:15-6:30 p.m.) to the preparation area in the Bell Center inside of the Knapp. The Bell Center is on the same level as the basketball court/Graduation Stage. Graduates please enter through the doors on 27th Street. Graduates will get their ticket to the Senior Party. **NO BALLOONS. NO NOISE MAKERS. NO SILLY STRING!**
