Homecoming Dance Ticket Information! All Roosevelt students requesting to bring a non-Roosevelt student to Homecoming must complete a 2016 Homecoming Dance Date request form. The form may be picked up in the Vice Principal's office from the counter. The form must be returned to the Vice Principals' office by Thursday, September 15, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. This form requires the signature of an administrator of the guest's school and must be turned in to purchase a ticket. The minimum grade level for all guests is ninth grade, and all guests must be under the age of 20. ***Only one guest is allowed per Roosevelt student.*** **PHOTO IDs MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL EVENTS BY BOTH PARTIES**

Homecoming Dance The Homecoming dance, ***Roosevelt Carnival***, will be held on Saturday, September 17 at the Community Choice Credit Union at Vets Memorial Hall, **7:00 – 10:00 p.m.** Dance tickets will be sold Monday, September 12 through Thursday, September 15. **NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD ON FRIDAY OR AT THE DANCE.** Students must have a valid Roosevelt ID to purchase a ticket AND to be admitted into the dance. Cost of a ticket is \$10. GUEST TICKETS for students who do not attend Roosevelt are sold only in the Vice-Principal's office with a completed 'Dance Date' form (available in the VP office). **BUY YOUR TICKET EARLY – AVOID THE LONG LINES AFTER SCHOOL ON THURSDAY!**

Homecoming Dance Ticket Sale Information TRHS students may buy a maximum of 2 tickets.

- For THEIR ticket, students must have their own ID.
 - For THEIR DATE OR FRIEND'S ticket, students must present that person's TRHS ID.
- NO ONE MAY PURCHASE MORE THAN 2 TICKETS OR A TICKET FOR A GUEST FROM ANOTHER SCHOOL. Guest tickets for students from other schools are only sold in the Vice- Principal's office with a completed 'Dance Date' form.

*****YOU MUST HAVE YOUR TICKET AND ID FOR ADMITTANCE TO THE DANCE !!!!***

IF YOU HAVE LOST YOUR ID OR ARE A NEW STUDENT, PLEASE SEE THE SECRETARY IN THE VICE-PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE ASAP. A \$5 REPLACEMENT FINE WILL BE CHARGED. PAYMENT FOR REPLACEMENT ID'S MUST BE MADE WHEN PLACING THE ORDER.

- Without an ID you will not be able to purchase a ticket or be admitted to the dance.
- Don't wait until Thursday if you need an ID. Take care of it today!!!
