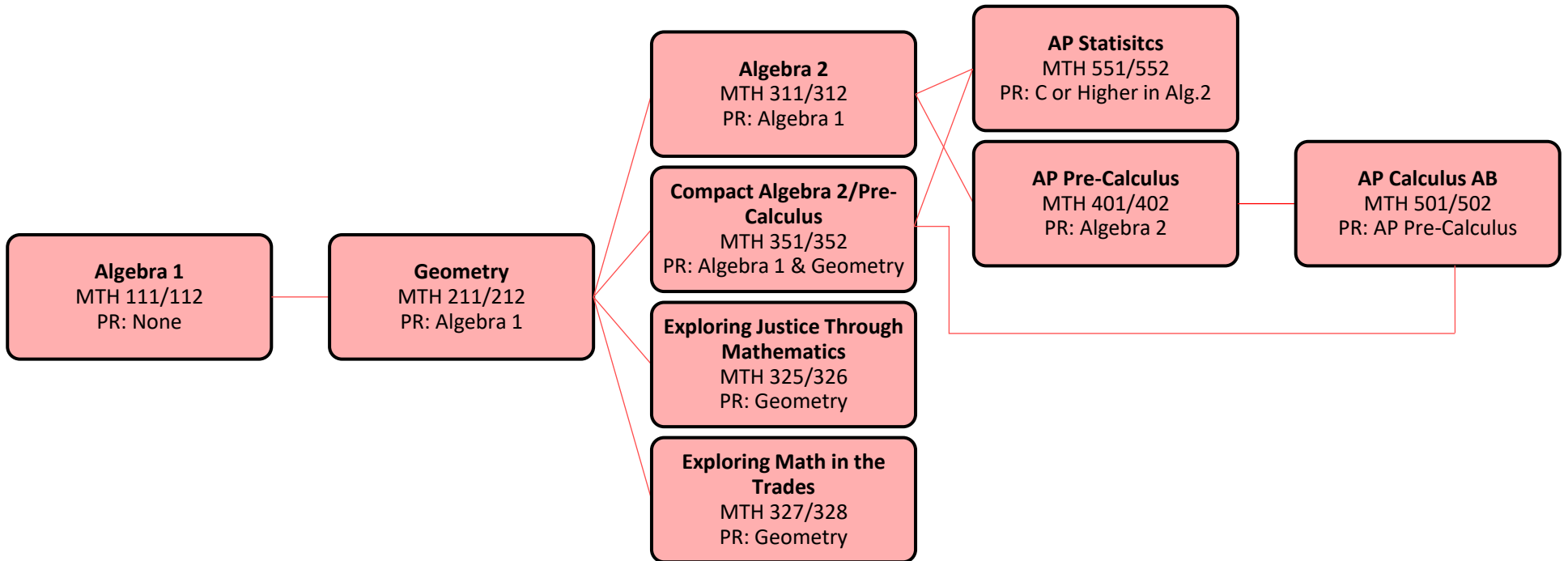

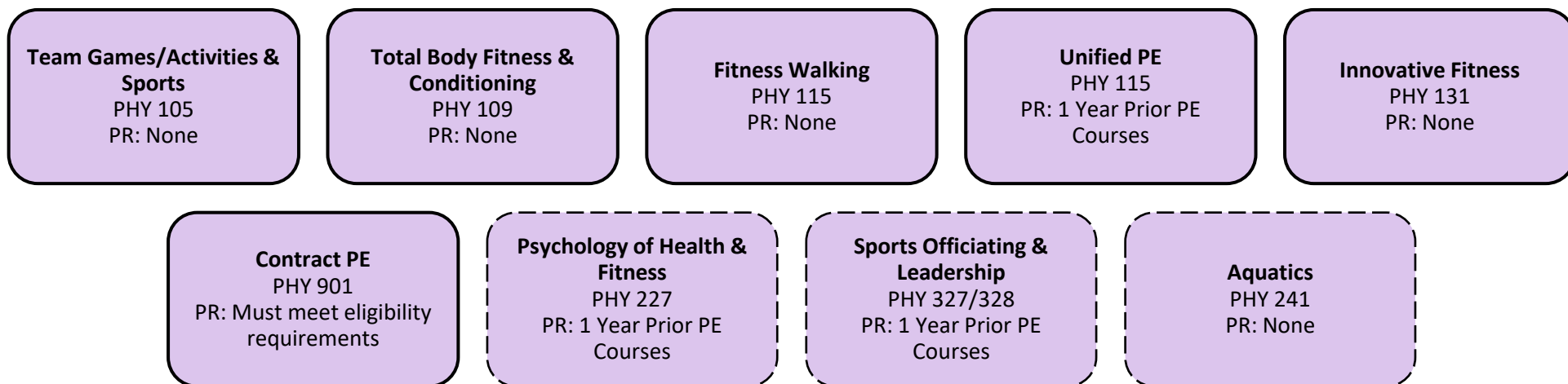
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Physical Education

1.0 Credits Required

Per state law, you must take one semester of PE every year. CPR is required for graduation and is taught within PE curriculum free of charge. PE Courses can be repeated; you can take the same PE class every year if you would like.



High school students are eligible to enroll in Contract PE provided they meet all of the following criteria:

- Student is carrying a full academic schedule* for the current semester.
- Student has no physical education failures to make up from previous years.
- Student is involved in a school-sponsored athletic or activity** supervised by a staff member with a coaching endorsement.

12th Grade students are eligible to enroll in Contract PE for one semester of their senior year provided they meet one of the above listed criteria.

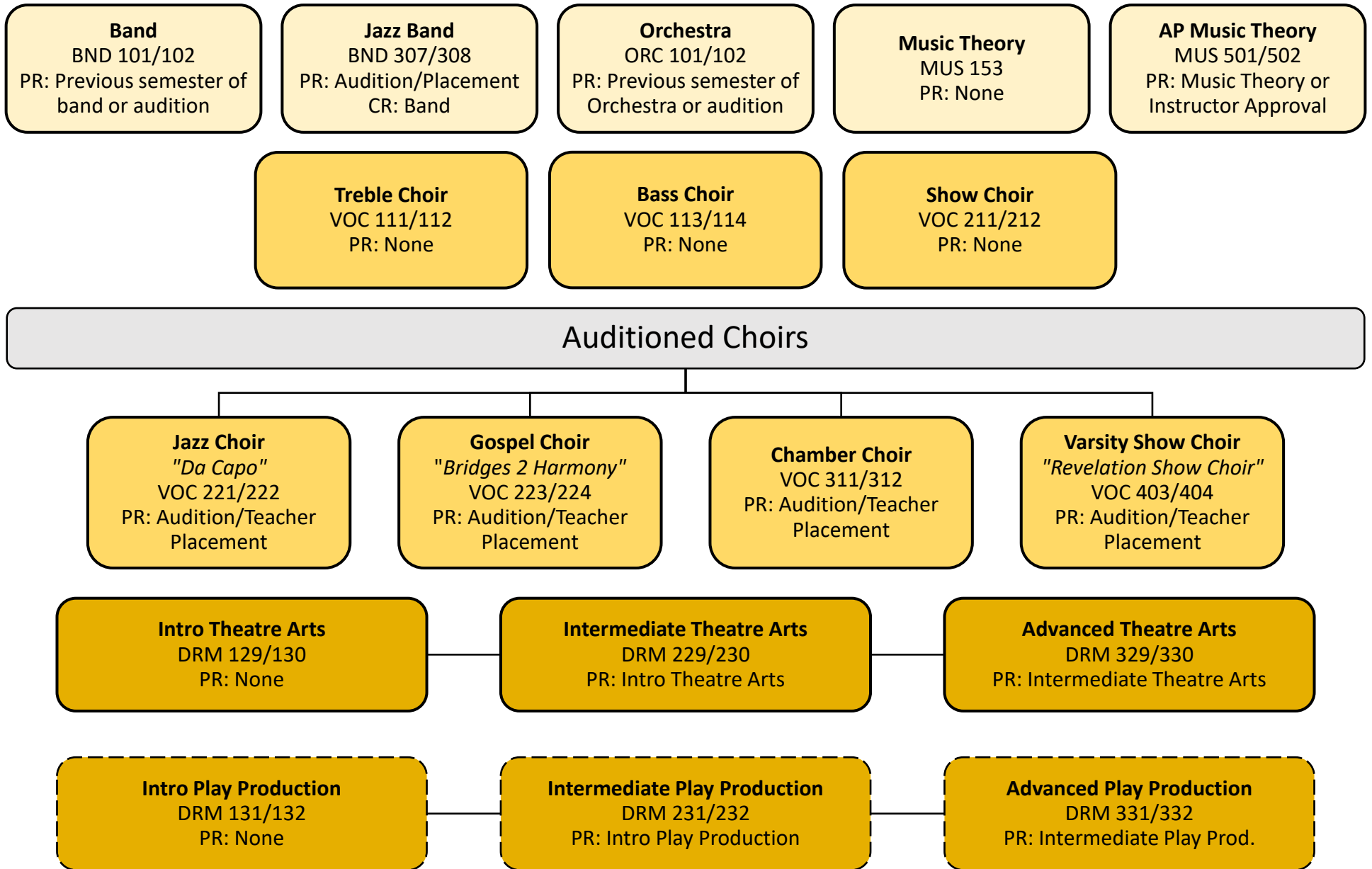
*Full academic schedule- Student is enrolled in classes with no release periods

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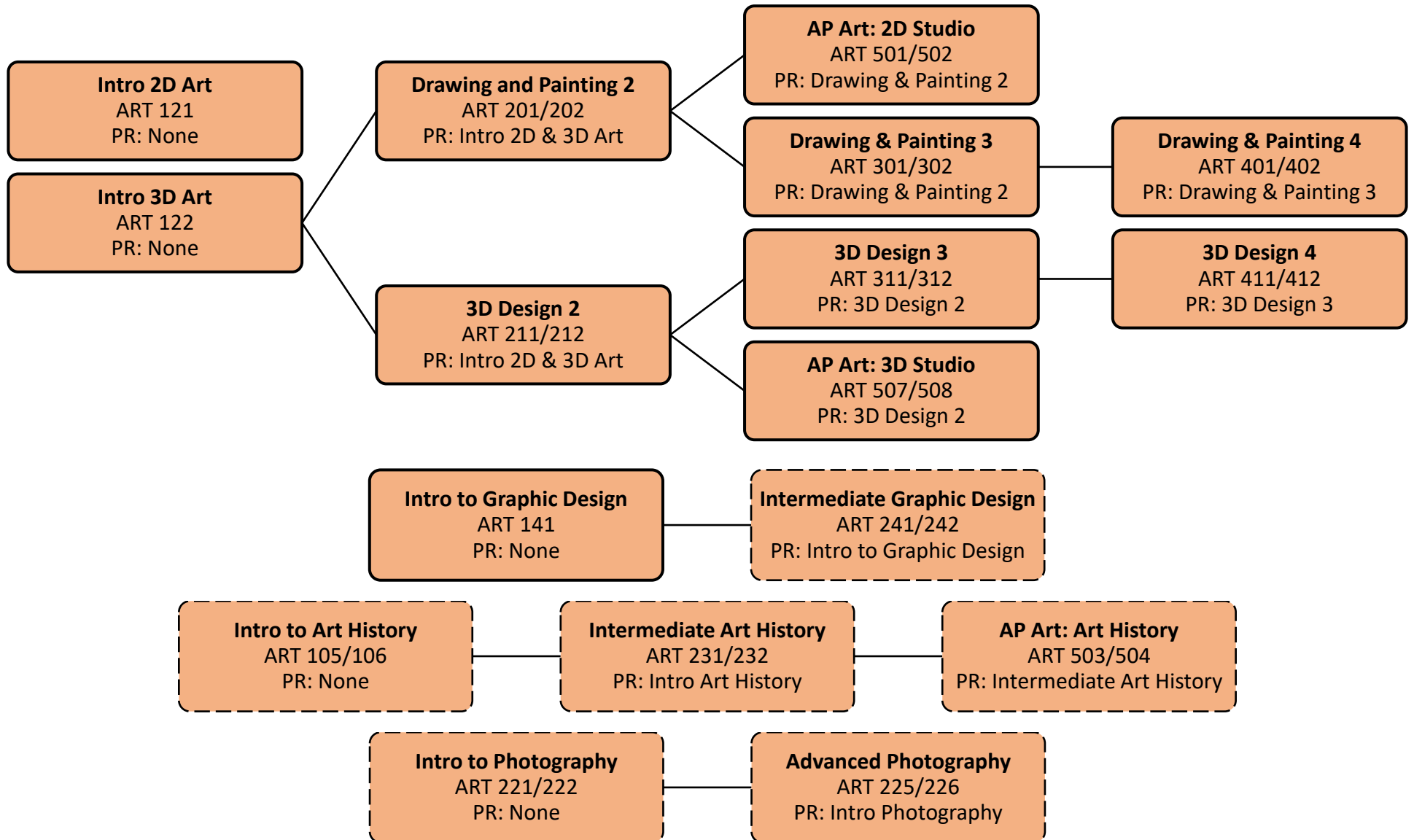

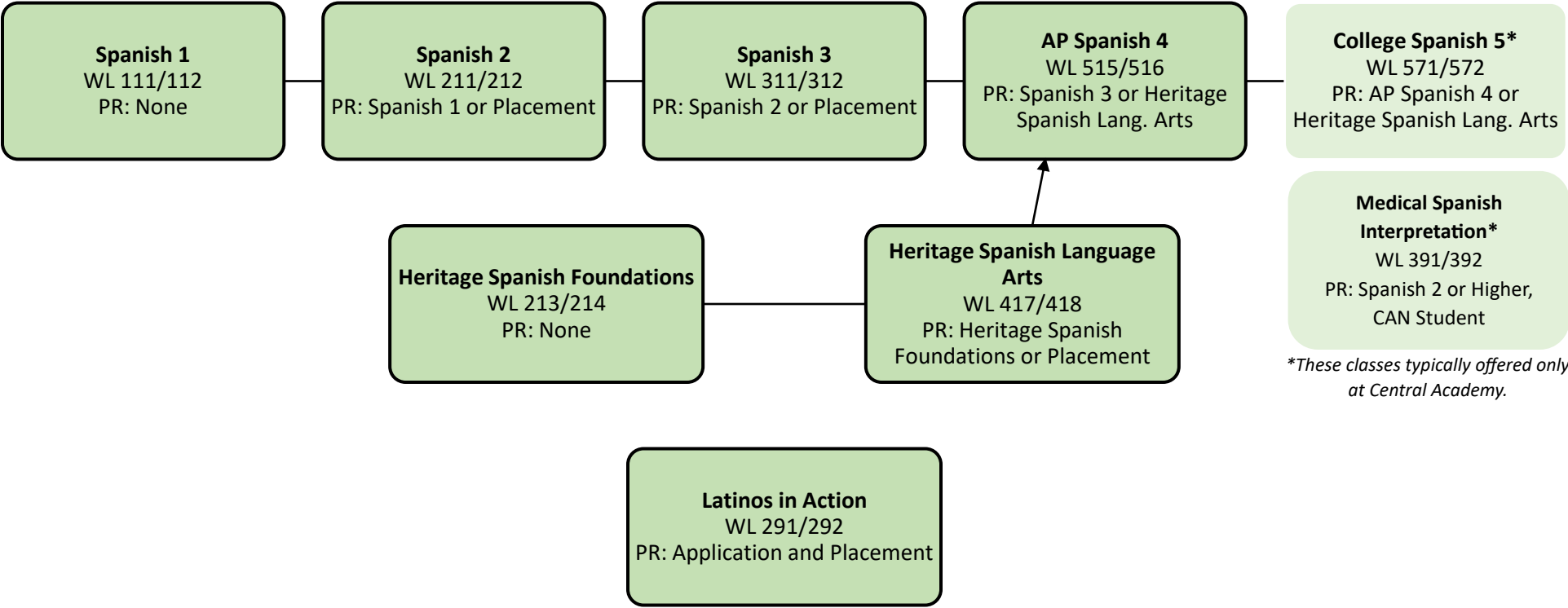

Solid lined border – Courses that are typically offered

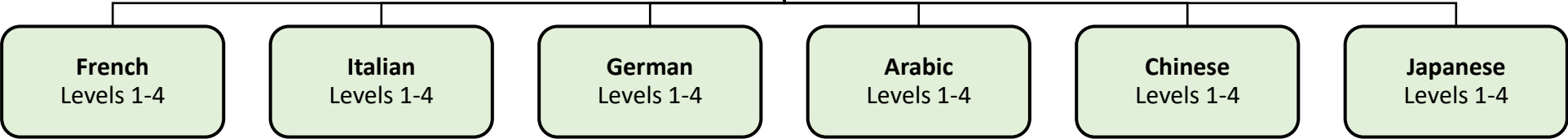

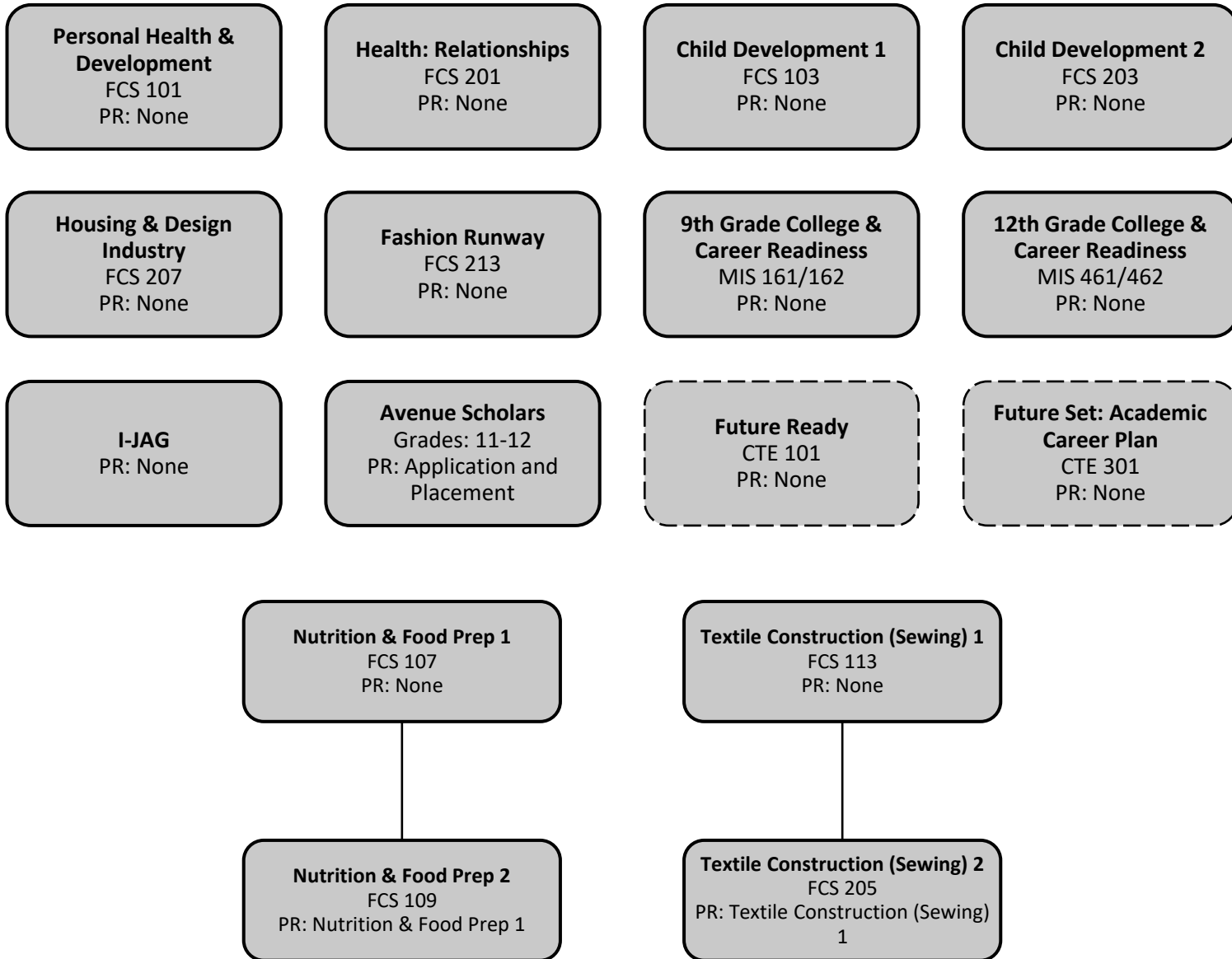
